Trou d'Ira. T1-C32. (-140m). Good shortish vertical cave.

Trou qui Souffle. T1-C57. Lots of different trips possible.

Grotte de Roche Chalve T1-C15. (-132m). Good cave to start with.

Orange

Grotte Berger. T1-C2

Scialet du Tonnerre. T1-C27 (-560m) fun, vertical & sporting cave. 12-18 hrs.

Red

Grotte Vallier. T1-C28. (-393m). 99m pitch near bottom. 8-12 hrs.

Grotte de Bournillon. T2-C66 (-46m). Classic cave w/ huge entrance & big galleries.

Grotte de Gournier. T1-C17. (Amazing ambience. The most beautiful river in Alps).
The big return trip takes 18-28 hrs.

Trou Spinette T2-C68. (-460m). Recent find of importance. 12-18 hrs. Big SRT trip.

Scialet Vincens T2-C69. (-403m). Looks like mod. difficulty SRT trip. 8-12 hrs.

Scialet des Sarasins. T2-C49. (-450m). Nice cave & easiest -400m trip in Vercors.

Scialet du Blizzard T2-C36. (-674m). One of the best caves in the Vercors. 7-11 hrs.
16-24 hrs.

Gour Fumant. T2-C63. (-163m). It's an excellent cave to start with. Beautiful & easy.

Scialet du Pot du Loup. T2-C64. (-94m). Short trip. Beautiful cave!
