## BROWN HILL POT, EAST KINGSDALE

Sat 9<sup>th</sup> and Sun 10<sup>th</sup> February 2008

### Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> February 2008

**Brown Hill Pot**, a classic tight and deep Yorkshire pothole. I've tried to get to the bottom once reaching somewhere near the top of the first pitch before retreating. There were only two of us and it needs more people to carry the rope. The entrance series is tight and sporting and there are four good-sized pitches further into the cave (apparently!). The largest pitch is the Puits Ian Plant at 56m.

Likely trip length is 8 hours to the bottom and back out. See 'Not for the Faint Hearted' p123.

Other info:

- SRT trip.
- Oversuit/undersuit or wetsuit.
- Requires dry conditions so may have to do an alternative trip.
- Meet at Inglesport at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday morning.
